

This is a little bluegrass flatpicking piece with a lot of rolls across the strings and some typical bluegrass licks. Its medium tempo and had the chords sequence:

G / G / D / C G
G / G / D / C G

D / D / G / D G

G / G / D / C G

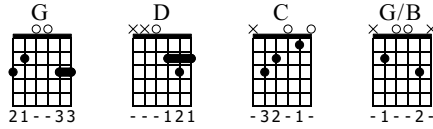
This is a 1, 4, 5 Progression in the key of G, the main bluegrass key (5 string banjos are tuned to G), and almost all bluegrass songs are based upon a 1, 4, 5 progression. So in the main keys, this would be:

1 4 5
G: G C G
D: D G A
C: C F G
A: A D E
E: E A B

Its flatpicked throughout using alternate picking which is indicated on the tab
